Plans to improve traffic flow in Chittenden County

Colchester, Vermont - December 14, 2011

Plans for improving traffic flow in Chittenden County will be presented to the public the evening of Dec. 14.

After the governor shelved the Circumferential Highway in May, transportation planners got to work designing smaller, localized solutions to traffic congestion. They have agreed on five projects, including a new interchange off Exit 16 in Colchester, and the construction of the so-called Crescent Connector to bypass the Five Corners in Essex Junction.
