1) Welcome and Overview

2) Review of Presentation to the Colchester Selectboard

The group discussed the following items:

- The need for pedestrian access on the overpass for emergencies (there are not likely to be many pedestrians regularly using the overpass now). There is a possibility for future transit in this area that may induce pedestrian demand.
- Bicycle safety on the overpass and vehicle lane widths.
- Combine "Package 1" and "Package 2" improvements into one.
- Instead of using detailed Level of Service (LOS), summarize performance results.
- If possible, add a graphic of a 5-lane cross section on the overpass.
