How would you CHANGE Winooski Ave?

For downtown section, make 4 lanes into 2 lanes and add bike lanes + metro!

PROTECTED BIKE LANES!

more Roundabouts ☺
↳ w/ training.

Gotta preserve parking. This is dense residential!
↳ protect bikes w/ parked cars!

bike lane (parking on only one side of parking lot)

only affordable housing developments - really affordable, not luxury,
more housing + neighborhood stores - more trees + gardens

PROTECTED Bike lanes / keep cars separate

How would you change Winooski Ave?

✓ Peel through main - 3 lanes with center lane for left turns. Two bike lanes

• On parts of the street where a bike lane is not possible due to parked cars. Create a green way indicating to cars that bikes can take the full width. example: Riverside to Decatur

• extend the North Union bike line past the food shelter drive way to meet S. ~~Winooski~~ Winooski.
★ Make it easier to enter into S. Winooski and turn left.

• Maintenance of bike lanes... (S. Winooski in particular)
• Consider: 1-way (Southbound) on Winooski from Decatur to Howard
1-way (Northbound) on Union from Howard to Decatur/Howard.

Winooski Avenue Corridor



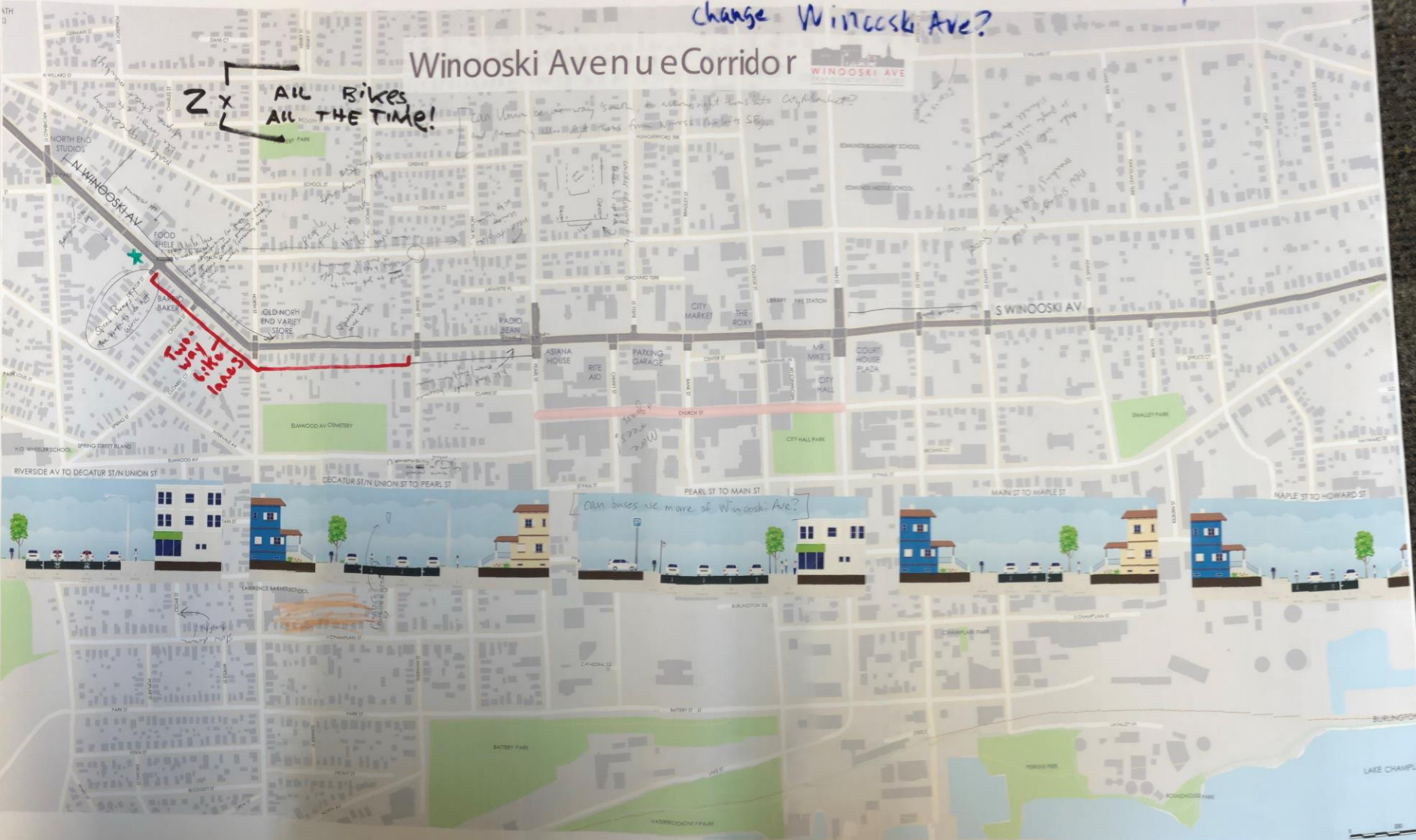
