Rethink Runoff is currently accepting designs for a storm drain mural campaign that will take place in Milton on Monday, July 29th. Artists will paint murals that illustrate the importance of keeping the water that enters storm drains clean.

The purpose of the mural project

is to raise public awareness about stormwater runoff.

Of the designs received, two artists will be selected to paint their murals on sidewalks adjacent to stormdrains. Each artist will receive a \$250 stipend upon successful completion of their mural.
