CCRPC requests two CWAC volunteer to serve on the UPWP Committee for FY23. The CCRPC develops a [Unified Planning Work Program \(UPWP\)](#) to serve as the annual work plan for local and regional transportation projects and other planning activities. Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) are required to develop UPWPs to govern work programs for the expenditure of FHWA and FTA planning funds. Updated annually, the CCRPC's UPWP describes our numerous programs and identifies the transportation, land use and other planning activities and projects that the CCRPC is engaged in collaboration with its member municipalities and other state and regional partners.

As in previous years, a UPWP Committee made up of representatives from the Board, the TAC, PAC, CWAC, VTrans, FHWA, and GMT will oversee the UPWP development process and provide a recommended work plan to the CCRPC Board.
