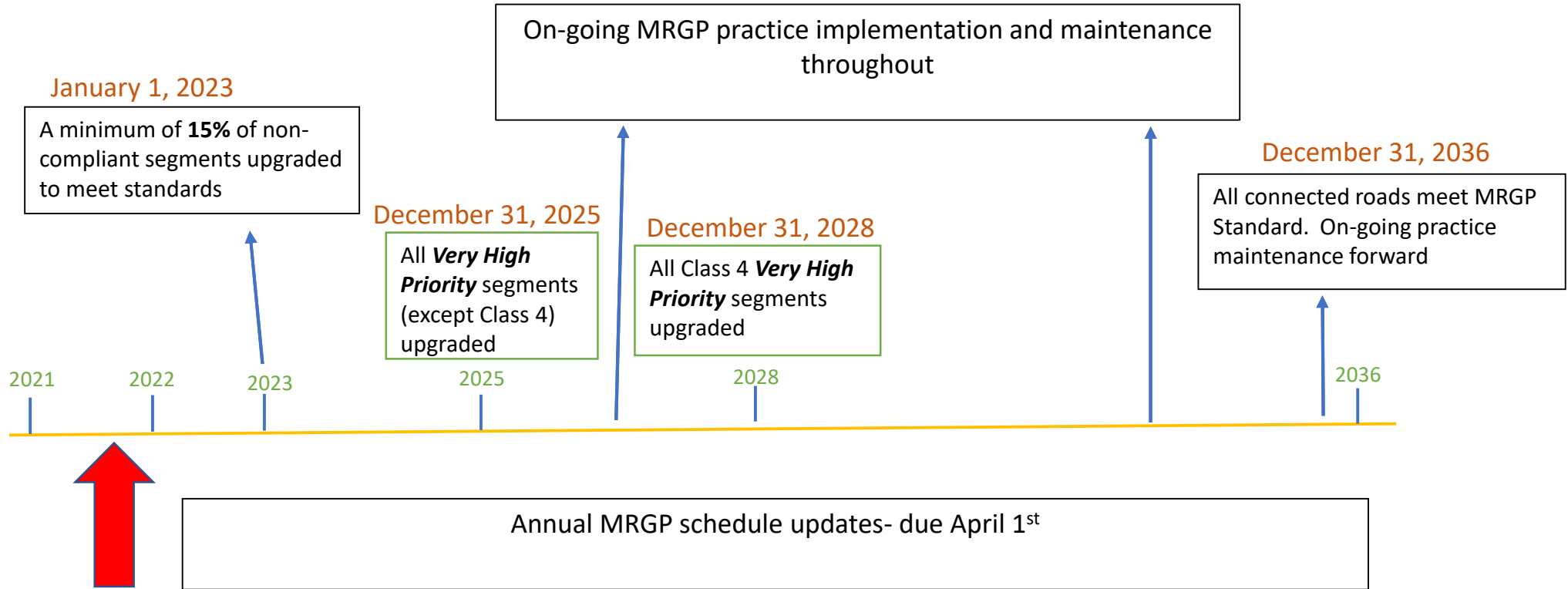

MRGP Timeline of Deliverables



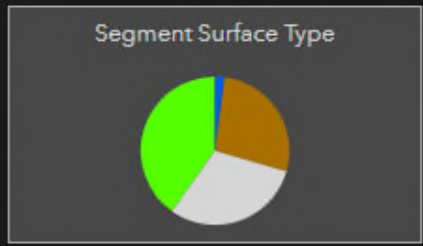
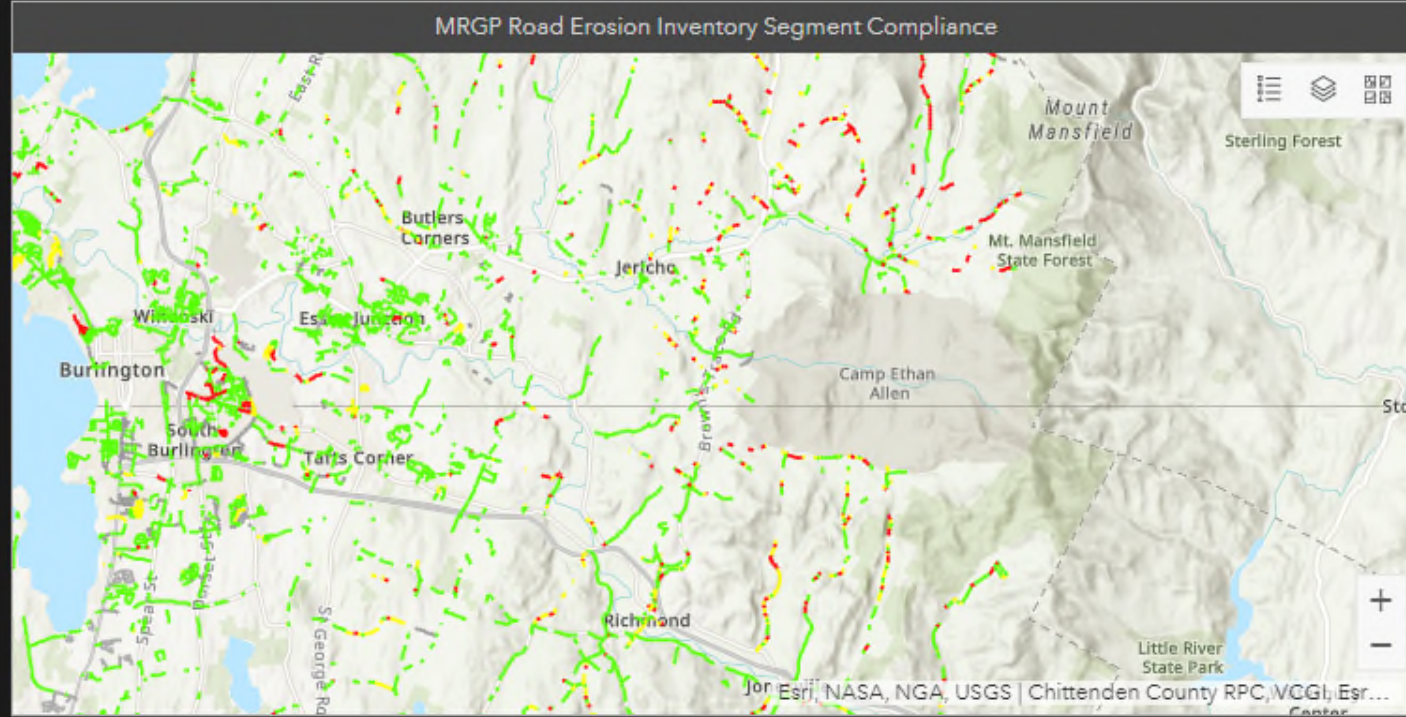
