- Added Functional Class Discussion (Major / Minor Collectors) and Support for 10' lanes
- Cochran Road Alts Reorganized from simplest to most complex.
- Is 'improved path" of crushed gravel incompatible with zoning regulation as trail is in floodway? Answer: Ravi and Bryan will check. Issue might relate to excavation and/or fill needs relative to Town standards, in addition to any State needs.

- Question for committee should a public input process be integrated into Prioritization Matrix? Allen: doesn't recall public viewing rankings from phase 1 prioritization matrix.
- Question for committee thoughts about Equity issue in Phase 2? Important issue, and ECOS Opportunity Index can potentially be utilized. Plus census blocks and low/moderate income data.
- Note: transportation committee already applying for grants (Bridge Street, Jericho Road), but these are not the top 1 or 2 projects. We could add a "Project Readiness" column, which should increase the overall score for such projects.
- Matrix process is largely an "in house" guidance document to help identify the best projects for Richmond.
