## Completed Administrative Tasks

- Invoice and reporting
- Spending down the FY22 budget currently at \$6,414.65
- Created FY 23' budget for approval and FY24' draft budget
- Received and distributed the new Rethink Runoff Stream Team merchandise, if you haven't received a shirt or hat and would like one, please let me know!
- Completed the Bi-weekly water sample season for the LaRosa Partnership Program.
- Adopt a Drain meeting with involved towns on August 5th
- Adopt a drain update:
- was 170lbs, 79 adopted drains, 64 adopters→ NOW: 232lbs of debris removed, 140 drains adopted, and 105 storm drain adopters!
- Communicated with town reps about what projects they would like to see in their respective communities:
  - Milton: Adopt-a-drain, sign at Rain Garden and stencils on storm drains around time- reached out to Milton High school for volunteers, Dave Barron drafted a Rain Garden sign
  - Williston: rain garden and informational signage, coordinating with Kate Kelly and Andrea Morgante on rain garden design.
  - Winooski: Stream Clean up along Morehouse Brook Sept. 24th, and potentially a smaller Rain barrel workshop in the spring.
  - Shelburne: Awaiting a response on the Saturday morning farmers market tabling, and potentially a tire round up along Munroe Brook
  - Burlington: Storm Drain Mural during Art Hop September 9-11th
  - South Burlington: No current projects at this time.
  - Essex: Adopt a drain
  - Essex Junction: Adopt a drain
  - Colchester:Adopt-a-drain

## Completed Event/Project Driven Tasks

- Adelaide completed the water quality monitoring at Indian 10 sampling site (and other intermittent sites as needed) last sampling event 8/1
- Meeting with Christine Dougherty and Todd Goodwin about a rain garden installation in williston in spring 23'
- Contacted / coordinated volunteers and updated files on the Adopt-a-rain garden program
- Scoped out the tires under the bridge/in the stream on Munroe Brook in Shelburnewill be a larger engineering and restoration project than a simple tire round up.
- Contacted highschools (Milton, Winooski, and Essex) for environmental club volunteering opportunities (Adopt a drain and stream clean ups)
- Collected more rain barrels for the Winooski "mini" rain barrel workshop + / 15 people
- Scoped Morehouse Brook (winooski) out for a stream clean up- water is low but there
  is a good bit of trash along the stream and in the woods. Stream clean up planned for
  9/24
- Coordination with Dave Barron, Annie, Chelsea, Nick and Dave Allerton about rain garden signage at the Milton Rain Garden Mock signage:

- Sent town reps a narrative for the Adopt-a-drain program for Front Porch Forum, a mailer for the program to go in the water bills, and a door hanger for the program.
- Reached out to Hamline University to ensure signs and welcome packets were being sent out to adopters.
