4. Clean Water Service Providers for Northern Lake Champlain, Lamoille & Winooski Basin

Dan Albrecht facilitate the meeting. The meeting was called to order at 11:05 a.m.

2. Changes to the Agenda and public comments on items not on the agenda None.

Dan Albrecht provided a briefing on Act 76 and the designation of CCRPC as the Clean Water Service Provider (CWSP) for the Northern Lake Champlain Basin. He highlighted the anticipated required annual phosphorus loading reductions in the Basin for the non-regulatory sector which will be the responsibility of the CWSP to achieve. As the CWSP, they will be provided approximately \$552,000 to disburse in grants starting next fiscal year He then described how as the CWSP they will get up and running this fiscal year. First, soliciting recruitment of members for its Basin Water Quality Council; working with DEC to identify potential projects, issuing an RFQ to pre-qualify engineering firms and project implementors (municipalities, watershed groups, land conservation organizations, natural resource conservation districts and others) so that as the CWSP, the CCRPC can quickly fund implementation/construction of recommended projects as well as design, operations & maintenance. Note that it is the Council that will prioritize projects, review their "scoring" for phosphorus reduction and co-benefits and vote on which projects to be funded. CCRPC sees its role as an administrator/manager and will be looking to many of the organizations here on this video meeting to actually implement these projects as they have the most suitable experience and skillset. Dan concluded his remarks with a more detailed explanation of how the nine-members will be recruited.

for which CVRPC was designated as the CWSP. They will hold two, repeat information sessions, one on December 8<sup>th</sup> and the other on December 15th. They are also currently recruiting nominations for

municipal BWOC members. Dean Pierce of Northwest Vermont RPC, which will serve as the CWSP for the Lamoille and

Mississquoi Basins, made similar comments to Dan and Grace. NRPC held a virtual information

session on November 30<sup>th</sup> regarding CWSP startup for that basin. He will be sending out solicitations for municipal BWQC member nominations as well as RPC representatives. Minor clarifying questions were asked of Dan, Grace and Dean and answered accordingly.

5. Overview of Draft DEC FY23 Clean Water Budget

Dan highlighted what he considered an excellent presentation given by various state agency personnel to the Clean Water Board at their November 4<sup>th</sup> meeting. The document is loaded on our Committee page and members are encourage to read through it as it lays out very clearly the different sources of funding the Vermont Clean Water Initiative will disburse and the types of projects that have been and will be funded. Dean Pierce noted that the Board would be meeting next week on December 14<sup>th</sup>.
