a) Sunset Drive Bioengineered Shoreline – Lake Shoreland Implementation – South Hero:

Project Manager = South Hero Land Trust - P-reduction = 3.65 kg/year; \$ requested = \$101,946

This project addresses the shoreline erosion along three neighboring properties on the west side of Keeler Bay, specifically at 32, 34, and 36 Sunrise Drive. These shorelines are severely eroded, threatening existing vegetation along the shore. The ongoing erosion leads to the loss of both sediment and nutrients into Keeler Bay, a sheltered bay in South Hero that is experiencing elevated phosphorus levels. A bioengineered shoreline stabilization approach is recommended to protect and restore native shoreland vegetation.

b) Lake Forest Condos – Stormwater – Implementation – Burlington:

Project Manager = CCRPC - P-reduction = 30.02 kg/year; \$ requested = \$668,439

Final design is now complete. Permit applications are ready to be filed. The proposed project will drain, dredge and deepen the existing wet pond to treat offsite runoff and also install an outlet filter to further treat phosphorus. The CCRPC will also concurrently construction improvements to two smaller HOA-related ponds for which the HOA will be billed.
