a) Pelots Point Road - Shoreline Stabilization - Town of North Hero - Implementation

P-reduction = 8.97 kg/year; \$ requested = \$124,519

At Pelots Point Road, a stone toe is recommended up to 101 feet elevation. This protective toe will sit directly on bedrock. The road elevation varies from an elevation of 106 to 109 feet, based on VCGI LIDAR data. This leaves 6 to 9 feet of elevation to install bioengineering practices such as encapsulated soil lifts. The presence of ledge at the site will make any excavation more challenging but provide an opportunity for very secure mounting of stone and other practices.
